- 1. EXHIBITION The ARTIST agrees to exhibit artwork in the Heritage Center. A non-refundable fee of \$20.00 per piece of art will apply (based on available space.) The space allotted each artist will be 7' X 7'
- 2. Artwork will be on display on Sunday, January 23, 2022 from NOON to 6:00 p.m. The ARTIST agrees to replace any sold items with another appropriate piece of art. Giclee renderings are acceptable but must be appropriately labeled.
- 3. DELIVERY & INVENTORY The ARTIST will arrange for delivery of work to the Heritage Center in the morning of January 23, 2022 between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. EXHIBIT OPENS TO THE PUBLIC

at 12:00 Noon. Please be aware that the artwork you choose to exhibit MUST be appropriate for the general public and that the IRCHS Art Committee retains the right to exclude individual pieces from the exhibition. Depending on the number of artists who register, we may have to limit the number of works each artist may display. *Please indicate artwork for the exhibition on the attached sheet*.

- 4. SALE OF WORK We require that the ARTIST or artist's representative will be present during the times that the exhibition is open. All entries must be available for sale. Any sales made are strictly between the ARTIST and the buyer. ARTIST must collect and pay his/her own 7% sales tax. The ARTIST will retain 85% of any sales made during the show, 15% of the sale will be donated to the IRCHS fundraiser on the day of the event. Credit/Debit cards may not be accepted. Exhibited works in the Junior division (ages 14-18) will be for display only and not for sale.
- 5. INSURANCE While IRCHS and its staff will take utmost care to protect the artwork, the artwork is on display at the ARTIST'S risk. Neither IRCHS nor its staff can be held responsible for any damages that may occur at any time before, during and after the exhibition of the artwork. The ARTIST is responsible for any personal insurance, if desired.
- 6. EXHIBITION-READY WORK We ask each artist to provide their own easels, sculpture stands, and the like to properly display their artwork.
- 7. PROMOTION OF THE SHOW News of the show will appear on the IRCHS website. In addition, we will alert the Cultural Council as well as local papers and magazines. We encourage artists to help spread the news of the show via whatever social media they may choose to utilize.
- 8. ARTWORK REMOVAL The ARTIST agrees to remove unsold artwork at the end of the show on Sunday afternoon, January 23, 2022 no sooner than 6:00 p.m. and no later than 7:00 p.m.

The parties agree that this is the entire agreement between the parties concerning the matter addressed herein and all prior written or oral negotiations and agreements are merged herein. A signed copy of this agreement (contract) must be emailed or mailed to the Indian River County Historical Society (Attention Patricia Kroger) no later than December 20, 2021. Checks are payable to Indian River Historical Society.
